Being Holy

You should be holy because God is holy. But first you must:

BELIEVE

Be holy by obeying your parents.

OBEYING

Holiness starts at home.

Be holy by not stealing, lying, cheating, or hurting others.

NOT LYING

True love for God will manifest itself in a love for others.

Be holy by loving those around you as yourself.

LOVING

Holiness comes from the heart.

The reason for being holy is because God is holy. His people are to reflect His character. There are many particular laws in Leviticus, but they are summed up by loving God, loving others, and being distinct from the world.
